Preparing Your MA Art History Application Professional Statement:

When preparing your Professional Statement, consider that the MA Admissions Review Committee is interested in what you will be able to contribute to the MA in Art History during your year in London. The exercise is not a personal account of why you like art or art history. Think about what you can bring to the MA in terms of your academic, professional and personal experience, especially if this experience meets the ethos of the MA. You might consider the relevance to you of the MA's unique focus on inter-cultural and methodological issues, as well as the focus on modernisms and postmodernism in the Spring semester. You might discuss your experience in the arts, such as working in a gallery or museum. You may also reflect on the way in which the MA, and a year in London – an international center of the arts, will challenge and enhance your approach to art history as well as your personal development.
