

A Guide to Course Designations

Discipline codes have now changed to 3 character codes – the previous codes are equivalent and if the course number is unchanged then the course is identical. For instance, *Introduction to Politics and Government* is currently coded PLT 150 and was previously coded POL 150. Some new disciplines have been introduced (e.g., ACC) and others are not currently offered or have been replaced. Some previously cross-listed courses are now only listed in one discipline e.g. (ANTH/PSYC 201 is now PSY 202).
