### Getting started

To use the Richmond's wireless network you will first have to register yourself and your laptop. You do this online shown in the URL below. On these pages are our terms and conditions for using the network and instructions in how to complete the registration form.

Please allow up to 24 hours the the registration to be processed.

### Hardware requirements

You will need a Laptop running OS 10.4 or greater and has a built-in airport card.

- Open the **Applications** folder in Finder and launch **Internet Connect**. Select AirPort tab.
- Pull down the **File** menu and select **New 802.1X Connection**.
- Select the new 802.1X tab and enter you Richmond Student ID with your network login password.

For the **Wireless Network**, use the dropdown menu and choose **ruairnet**.

This is shown in Fig.1.1

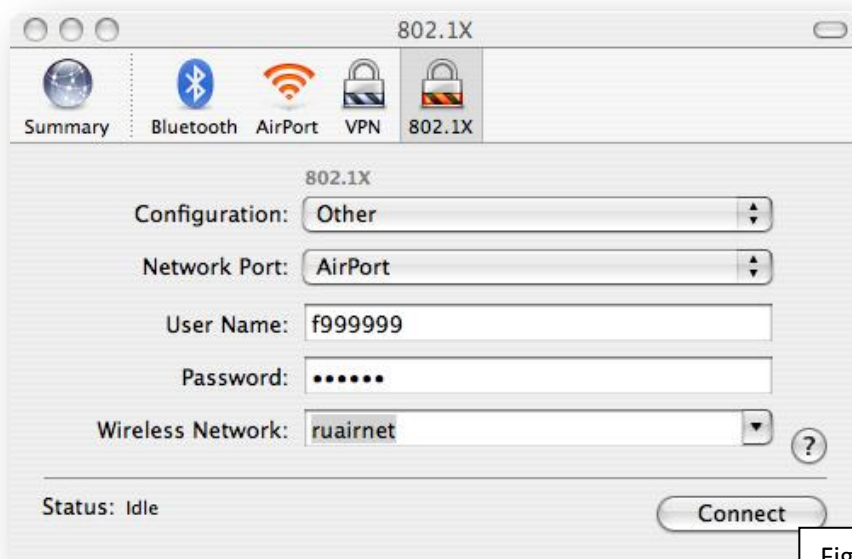

- Click back on the Airport tab. It will ask you to save your changes. Enter ruairnet and click save.
- Pull down the Network drop-box and select ruairnet.
- It should now say you are **Connected to “ruairnet”** at the bottom. If you see a warning appear . Click the **Continue** button.



Now all you will need to do is open your Internet browser to surf the Internet.

If your laptop does not connect in this way , please request information on how to connect using a network key.
